Emilia-Romagna Region, as a project partner, is deploying its consolidated activities in the prevention of food waste in order to disseminate in Europe an innovative model already successfully implemented and in continuous evolution. More specifically, the project is aimed at enhancing the experience gained in Emilia-Romagna through the development and use of the S.I.R: the software platform allows to manage fresh fruit and vegetable products surplus, which is collected through the measure of "withdrawals from the market" and distributed to charities, considered extremely avant-garde in the European panorama.
